Recommended Daily Feeding

2-5 lbs.	1/4 - 1/3 cup	33-45 gm
6-11 lbs.	1/3 - 1/2 cup	45-67 gm
12 lbs. & up	1/2 - 2/3 cup	67-90 gm

Offer up to two times recommended daily feeding for kittens.
